Other Tender clauses

Following clauses are in supersession of respective clauses mentioned in tender document and amendments issued earlier.

1. Performance Security

Within twenty one (21) days from date of the issue of notification of award by the Purchaser/Consignee, the supplier, shall furnish performance security to the Purchaser/Consignee for an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the total value of the contract, valid up to sixty (60) days after the date of completion of all contractual obligations by the supplier, including the warranty obligations, which is initially valid for a period of minimum six months plus number of months under warranty from the date of Notification of Award.

2. If EMD/BG validity is short as per tender requirement, a 2 weeks' time from the date of tender opening will be provided to the bidder for re-submission/correction of the submitted EMD/BG.

3. Tender validity

If not mentioned otherwise in the SIT, the tenders shall remain valid for acceptance for a period of 730 days (Seven hundred and thirty days) after the date of tender opening prescribed in the TE document. Any tender valid for a shorter period shall be treated as unresponsive and rejected.

- **4**. A Tenderer quoting imported items in INR will have to submit necessary documents like (This clause is applicable for Global tenders only).
 - a. Declaration confirming that the quoted items would be imported for the intended project (Tender reference number is to be quoted) only.
 - **b.** Bidder must submit Bill of Entry in the name of the project at the time of pre-dispatch inspection and with initial bill claimed documents. The documents should clearly state the name of the intended Project (Tender reference and/or Project Name) along with the quantities.
