This is for information to all the bidders that, following correction and addition is incorporated in the above tender:

**The following Condition has inserted for Preference to Make In India products:**

**Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore)**

Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as defined in Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products.

The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier will be as defined in Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017.

If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which no purchase preference shall be granted. In case the bid value is more than Rs 10 Crore, the declaration relating to percentage of local content shall be certified by the statutory auditor or cost auditor and if the OEM is a company then by a practicing cost accountant or a chartered accountant for OEM's other than companies as per the Public Procurement (preference to Make-in -India) order 2017 dated 04.06.2020.

Only Class-I and Class-II Local suppliers as per MII order dated 4.6.2020 will be eligible to bid. Non - Local suppliers as per MII order dated 04.06.2020 is not eligible to participate. However, eligible micro and small enterprises will be allowed to participate .In case Buyer has selected Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises clause in the bid, the same will get precedence over this clause.

The bidders are advised to take into account the Corrigendum before submission of their bids against this tender. If any bidder submitted his/her bid, then he/she should resubmit his/her bid taking into account the above Corrigendum.
